



SIGNAL WIRE PULLEY POSTS

10 cast posts
multiple pulleys, displaced vertically

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

The posts (or 'stumps') are fixed at 25' (100mm) intervals on straight track or at 15' (60mm) intervals on curves along the cinder edge between the ballast and the earth or grassed boundary of the formation, with the pulley blocks facing the track. Trim off excess pulley wheels to suit the number of wires in the run.

Allow for 'boxing' to be laid at positions where the signal wires go below ground such as at walkways for shunters and at level crossings etc. At the Signal Box, 'horses' made from old sleepers and large dished pulley wheels from MSE frets *LS006/1* or *LS007* should be added.

The cast posts represent cedar wood and should be painted a dull brown. The pulleys when new were galvanised and would be silver until weathered dull grey, with a hint of rust and oil.
