## Instructions

Do not apply the transfers to a dead matt surface. Generally, the glossier the surface, the better the adhesion of the transfer. Make sure the surface is clean, dry and grease-free. Cut roughly to shape around the transfer and dip in lukewarm water for 15-45 seconds, then slide the transfer from the backing paper directly onto the model, positioning it with an artist's paintbrush. **DO NOT LET THE TRANSFER FLOAT AWAY FROM THE BACKING PAPER.** When happy with the position, press into place GENTLY with a cotton bud or tissue and absorb excess water, ensuring removal of all air bubbles.

The varnish cover-coat is crystal-clear. Should you choose to leave it on the model it will never discolour. It is possible to peel the varnish cover-coat away to leave a factory-printed type finish. To do this successfully the transfer **MUST** be applied to a glossy surface, and **MUST** be left for at least 24 hours before removing the film. This is achieved by applying a low tack masking tape, such as Phoenix Precision PS11

or PS12 Low Tack Masking Tape, to a corner of the transfer and

GENTLY pulling the varnish cover-coat away. However, because of the thinness and clarity of the varnish it is not essential to remove it. You will still be left with a superb, non-yellowing finish that will do justice to your model.

We recommend that transfers are varnished to protect them from abrasion when wiping over with a cloth, which may contain minute abrasive particles. A suitable varnish is Phoenix Precision Paints PV62 Gloss or PV72 Satin Varnish.
