### Water tank panels

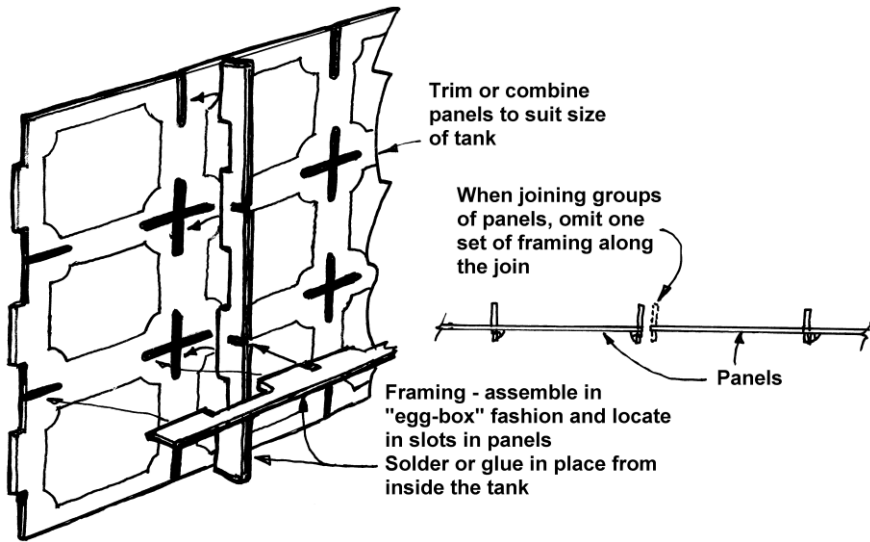
Based on the Midland Railway cast iron type

12 panels and framing

The assembly diagram below should be fairly self-explanatory. Once the four side panels are assembled to the required size, fix them together around a square or rectangular base. The whole tank is then mounted on a brick, stone or wooden base building, although grounded tanks are known, particularly for water softening plants.

The ladder runs between ground level and the top lip of the tank. You will need to join ladders together to give sufficient length. A single wire handrail runs around the top of the tank, with an access gap in line with the ladder. A float gauge should be fitted to one side of the tank, which can be made from two C-shaped brass sections placed together with a slot down the middle.

Some tanks appear to have been partly covered with loose planks, probably for maintenance purposes.
