These etched sides can be built into a complete coach using products from our range as supplied in our full kits. Please refer to the panel opposite. Should you prefer they can also be used as a basis for a scratchbuilt coach.

This 59' design just pre-dated the true Bulleid designs with their 64'6" length. The interior layout and décor reflected the earlier Maunsell style. They were formed into 3 coach sets with the matching Corridor Composites to D2316 (Comet Models S13).

Livery

As built they carried late SR malachite green with the legend 'Southern' centrally placed on the side. Numbers and class designations were SR 'Sunshine Yellow' with the set numbers on the ends in plain yellow. They were next repainted into BR crimson and cream, and from 1956 they were repainted BR SR stock green. In general the ends, underframe and bogies were black and the roof grey.

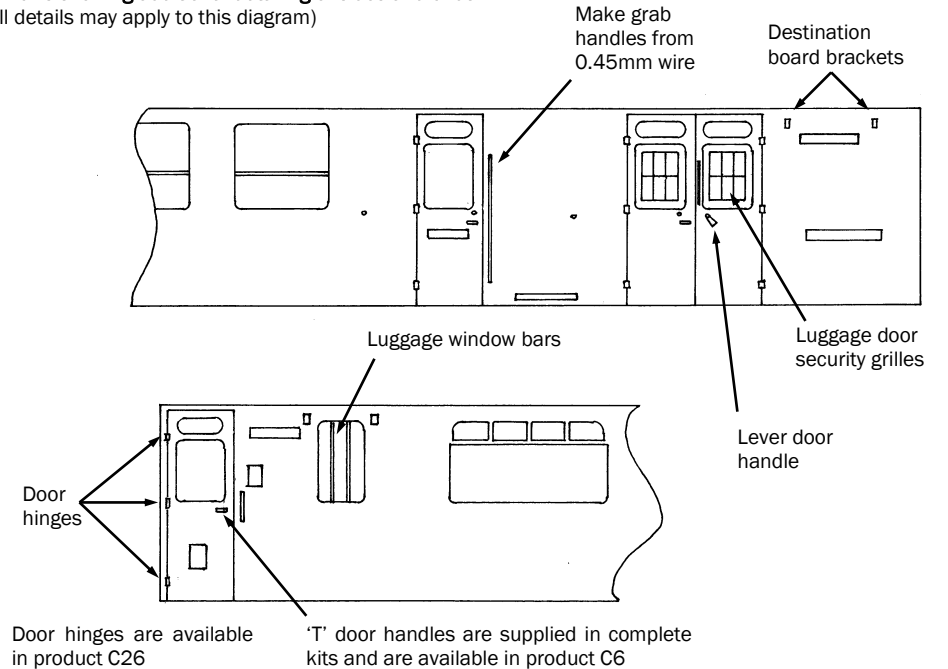

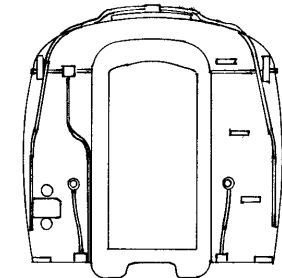
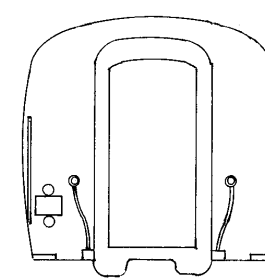
